

WHO IS CORVIAS?

Corvias is a corporation that provides housing for military families and higher education facilities. In 2020, union members conducted critical research to expose their history of prioritizing profit over safety.



A One-Sided Deal

At the beginning of the pandemic in March 2020, the USG was required to cover all the refunds of students in Corvias housing.

P3 Conflict

As USG schools moved to remote work, Corvias demanded that the USG lease beds from them to fulfill their financial bottom line-- beds that the USG had no use for. When the USG refused, **Corvias suggested that students would pay the price for USG's disagreement.**

Neglectful Dorm Maintenance

Corvias cut their budget with facilities at USG schools by 24 percent. Originally, the company had provided 57 staff members. After the cuts, there were only 10.

In short, **Corvias refused to meet its contractual obligations to USG because it was unprofitable.**



The Impact

- Corvias failed to uphold COVID-19 cleaning protocols
- No custodial staff at select P3 housing facilities
- USG schools forced to hire additional contractors to meet cleaning and maintenance requirements
- Students living in hazardous conditions
- USG Employees working in potentially fatal conditions
